

MINUTES OF GREENVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

FEBRUARY 11, 1997

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Council was called to order by Council President Janet Riggs at 7:30 P.M. at the Greenville Elementary School. Councilmembers Ted Miller, Mike Recevuer and Ray Gibson were present as well as the Clerk Treasurer Jack Sprigler.

Minutes of the January meeting was approved after dispensing with the reading on motion by Ted Miller, seconded by Mike Recevuer. Approved 4-0.

Indiana State Police Trooper Steve Didat presented the Council and those in attendance an overview of the Indiana State Police Area Problem Oriented Program. Following this presentation Trooper Didat passed out surveys concerning problem areas within the Town. He stated thses surveys are important to the Indiana State Police in dealing with increased patrols, citizens' concerns and other matters.

Leroy Terwilliger, representing his business in the Town stated he contacted the Indiana Highway Department and was advised by 50 or more reasons why the State will not put up a traffic light and the intersection of the Greenville/Georgetown and U.S. 150 roads. He suggested the Council initiate a petition for a stop light. Ted Miller suggested the Council obtain information from the State regarding procedures for the installation of a stop light.

Marshal David Moore stated he would like to see a "partnership" arrangement with State, County and Town, to control traffic.

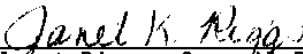
Don perkins present the Council with a map showing alleys he would like vacated. Mike Recevuer and Ted Miller reviewed the map with the Council and after discussion by the Council, advised him the Council would consider his request and inform him of the Council's decision.

Jeff Fifer, Attorney, stated he believed a settlement with SEICO for engineering services in the cancelled Utility project is possible if a Councilmember and someone knowledgeable with the circumstances surrounding the project could meet with SEICO. Ray Gibson stated he believed Bob Gibson, previous Consultant on the project may meet with SEICO to review their offer and that he also would be available. Fifer stated he would set up a meeting.

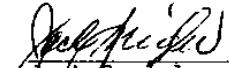
