

MINUTES OF GREENVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING, NOVEMBER 9, 1999.

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Council was called to order by Councilmember Ray Gibson at 7:30 p.m. with members David Matthews and Mike Receveur present. Also attending was Clerk Treasurer Jack Sprigler, Office Manager Janice Gibson and Marshal David Moore; and resident Jamie McKown. Council President Ted Miller and Utility Superintendent Gary Getrost arrived late due to a water meeting with Edwardsville Water Utility.

Mike Receveur motioned the minutes of the October meeting be approved as written and the reading to be dispensed. On call of the roll David Matthews and Ray Gibson voted "Aye" along with Receveur.

Mike Receveur motioned a "No Parking" sign be erected along the south side of Reisert Drive; motioned approved 3-0.

Ray Gibson motioned a fence be erected along the north side of the Town/Utility property on Reisert Drive (approx 500 feet). On call of the roll Matthews and Receveur voted "Aye" along with Gibson. The cost to be borne by the Utility.

Council by a vote of 3-0 approved water bill adjustments in the amount of \$484.07.

Council also approved 3-0 credit with PC Building Materials with the stipulation that they be notified of the Town's payment schedule and they so agree, with a limit of \$600.00, at any given time.

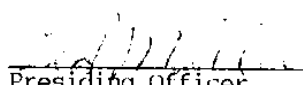
Council by a vote of 3-0 approved a threshold of \$300.00 for capital asset purchases. This applies to single purchases of this amount (\$300) and multiple purchases totalling \$300.

Janice Gibson apprised the Council that two (2) customers sharing the same meter well had their meters read wrong for a period of time resulting in an underpayment by one and an overpayment of the other. Ms. Carrie Marting (03-1330) overpaid in the amount of \$172.84 and William Rice underpaid this amount. Ms. Gibson requested the Council approve a refund (Credit Amount) of \$172.84 for Martin and charge off this amount for Rice (03-1330-01). By a vote of 3-0, the Council approved this transaction.

Ted Miller and Gary Getrost arrived at 8:00 p.m. and apprised the Council of their meeting. Gary stated Edwardsville Water Utility was putting up \$14,000 toward the cost of controls for Greenville towers and since the cost of these controls will be more than the \$25,000 requiring a bid the Council set Tuesday, November 16, 1999 at 7:30 p.m. for a special meeting to discuss the matter.

Council approved 4-0 claims for the Town/Utility.
