**RESOLUTION CONCERNING MAKING HARRISON STREET AT EAST
SECOND STREET A THREE WAY STOP WITHIN THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Greenville, Indiana, in the interest of public safety has determined it to be in the best interest for the protection of children at play to make Harrison Street at East Second Street a three way stop to control speeding on Harrison Street;

WHEREAS, a verbal motion was made at the Town of Greenville Council Monthly Meeting of September 10th, 2012 and passed by a vote of 5-0.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Stop signs shall be installed on Harrison Street, one facing west and one facing east at East Second Street {East Second Street already marked}. This shall make the intersection of Harrison and East Second Street a three way stop.
2. All sign posts shall be set in concrete to prevent removal.
