

MINUTES OF TOWN COUNCIL MEETING OF 9, 1992

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was called to order by President Ron Lamb. Councilmember Harold Hall was absent, as well as the Clerk Treasurer. Minutes of this meeting was taken by Janice Gibson.

Also attending was Gary Getrost, Jim Harl, Talbott Richardson, Williams Burkhart, Jr., Alice McIntosh (Cardinal Real Estate), Bud & Evelyn Stotts, Dan Page and Gary Gilmore.

Mr. Stotts informed the Council that he had purchased land in Greenville (from Mr. & Mrs. Voll) to put in a service station. Maps presented to the Council indicate a potential problem with the current existence of E. Harrison Street. Also there seems to be a problem with drainage.

Dan Page informed the Council he is developing Cedar Point, the area in Galena adjacent to the Citizens Fidelity Bank and desires a commitment from the Council for approximately thirty (30) meters. The Council stated they would take his request under advisement due to the current water situation and notify him of their decision.

Bob Williams reported to the Council that he had met with Dan Cristiani on the alleys and the drainage problem in front of Ray Gibsons property:

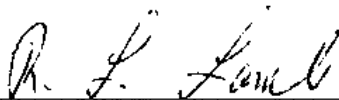
Dan Cristiani will shoot elevation at Mr. Gibsons' to determine what should be done. If any ditching is required on the Greenville/Georgetown Road the county will be responsible. The culvert under W. Harrison Street will be the responsibility of the town.

Mr. Cristiani will send quote on scraping and rocking the alleys.

Bill Burkhart will check into the parking problem in front of Papeno's Pizza, due to complaints being received by the town.

Janice Gibson was instructed to look into how the utility should proceed with discontinuing tap-ins due to the current water problem.

No further business coming before the Council Bob Williams motioned for adjournment, seconded by Ron Lamb.
