

MINUTES OF TOWN COUNCIL MEETING - SEPTEMBER 22, 1992

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Council was called to order by President Ron Lamb at 8:00 P.M.

Attending was Ron Lamb, Harold Hall, Ray & Vickie Gibson, Gary Gilmore, Bill Burkhart, Jr., Fred Marsh, and Vince Sommers.

The Council approved the minutes of the August meeting. Also approved was claims for the town/utility.

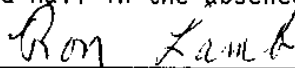
Ray Gibson asked to have a new culvert installed at the intersection of the Greenville/Georgetown Road and West Harrison Street. Council stated the work would be done as soon as possible.

SEICO representative, Mr. Vince Sommers stated he talked to Dan Luther of the Floyds Knobs Water Co. about the possibility of tying on to the Indiana Cities Water Co. system, to which Mr. Luther informed those present that such consideration was being discussed. Mr. Luther stated he was positive about the possibility of either adding an additional line or increasing the existing line. Fred Marsh, also of SEICO, stated that Mt. St. Francis has a 50,000 gallon tank that is 100 feet high, that could be tied into the system in sixty (60) days. Mr. Sommers said he will check with Mr. Luther and Indiana Cities later on the status of the proposed tie-in. Mr. Lamb said he will contact Mt. St. Francis and also check the possibility of service from the tank in the New Albany industrial Park (Indiana Cities).

A request was made by the Cemetery Board to hold their election of officers in the Town/Utility office. Council approved their request of a November date.

No further business coming before the Council Harold Hall motioned for adjournment, seconded by Ron Lamb.
