Also attending was the Clerk Treasurer, Marshal David Moore, Utility Superintendent Gary Getrost and Utility Office Manager Janice Gibson.

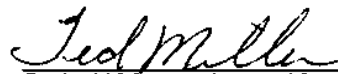
Minutes of the September meeting was approved 3-0 on motion by Mike Receveur.
