

## **Minutes of Greenville Town Council Meeting October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2013**

Council President Talbott Richardson called the regular monthly meeting to order. Other Councilpersons present were Bob Wright, Darryl Kepley, and Greg Redden, along with Clerk Jack Travillian. Also attending the meeting were Town Manager Randal Johnes, Marshal Bill Burkhardt, Water Superintendent Gary Getrost and several concerned citizens. The meeting was opened with a prayer from Pastor Jason Sparks, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Minutes:** The minutes for September 09<sup>th</sup> regular meeting and September 09<sup>th</sup> budget hearing were discussed. Motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden to accept the proposed minutes. Motion passed 4-0.

### **Marshal Report:**

Marshal Burkhardt presented the council members with the monthly report. The marshal's department has made a request to increase the fine fees on citations to bring it in line with the Floyd County fees.

The department sent two officers to a training seminar regarding the prescription drug epidemic. The department has been dealing with the Highway 150 construction and increased traffic on Clark and Harrison Streets. The department has worked several automobile break-ins and home break-ins, in response the department has increase overnight patrols. Chief Burkhardt would like to remind the public to make sure to lock their car when left unattended.

### **Financial:**

Review/Approval Checks and Expenditures: Clerk Travillian presented the forms for the checks written from the utility and the town. The checks were approved without objections.

### **Committee Reports:**

#### **Streets and Roads:**

President Richardson advised the council that the Highway 150 project should be completed by mid-November, weather permitting. The light will be automated with pads to change for cross traffic coming from the school or Greenville/Georgetown Road. Councilman Wright advised the council that Libs Paving has completed patching of the streets. He noted that several Stop signs were old and fading; the council requested recommendations about how many would need to be replaced.

**Town Manager:** Randal Johnes has posted his report on the town website along with emailing all council members and the clerk. No questions concerning the report.

**New Construction:** Terry Striha gave a construction update for his approved project, to the council showing a building and drainage options on his property located at 9101 Highway 150.

**Utility Business:**

Superintendent Getrost gave the monthly adjustment report. The council accepted the adjustments without comment.

Town Manager Johnes brought up the need for Jacobi, Toombs and Lanz Engineering firm to send a final bill to complete our Water Tower Construction project.

**Ordinance 2013-TO-050; 2014 BUDGET:** Second reading of the ordinance, motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden to accept the submitted budget. Motion passed 3-1. Voting for the budget was President Richardson and Councilmen Redden and Wright. Councilman Kepley voted against the budget. Third reading was completed. Motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden to accept the submitted budget. Motion passed 3-1. Voting for the budget was President Richardson and Councilmen Redden and Wright. Councilman Kepley voted against the budget.

**Ordinance 2013-MO-052 - ORDINANCE CONCERNING FINES PROVIDED BY THE ENFORCEMENT OF STATE OF INDIANA TRAFFIC LAWS WITHIN CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA AND PAYABLE TO THE FLOYD COUNTY TRAFFIC COURT SYSTEM:** First reading of the ordinance was completed and the motion was made for unanimous consent by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Wright. Motion passed 4-0. Second reading was completed. President Richardson made a motion to accept the ordinance and seconded by Councilman Wright. Motion passed 4-0. Third reading was completed. A motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Wright to accept the ordinance as amended (correcting address). Motion passed 4-0.

**Ordinance 2013-MR-053: RESOLUTION PROHIBITING SEMI-TRACTOR TRAILER TRAFFIC ON CLARK AND HARRISON STREETS WITHIN THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA;** Reading of the resolution was completed and the motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden. Motion passed 3-1. Voting for the resolution were President Richardson, Councilmen Wright, and Redden. Opposing the resolution was Councilman Kepley.

President Richardson reminded the council about special meeting concerning the needed increase in funding for the water utility to be held at Greenville Elementary School on Monday, October 21, 2013 from 6:00 PM till 8:00 PM. The council is requesting that consultant Buzz Krohn personally attends for a better explanation of the needed revenue.

Pastor Jason Sparks from Redeeming Vine Baptist Church noted that his church will be a collection center for the Christmas Child project. He had hand-outs with the information about how to give for the project.

No further business coming before the Council the meeting was adjourned.

## ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION FOR APPROPRIATIONS AND TAX RATE





Ordinance Number: 2013-TO-050

Be it ordained by the **Town of Greenville** that for the expenses of **GREENVILLE CIVIL TOWN** for the year ending December 31, **2014** the sums herein specified are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the several funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same. Such sums herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year, unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided for by law. In addition, for the purposes of raising revenue to meet the necessary expense of **GREENVILLE CIVIL TOWN**, the property tax levies and property tax rates as herein specified are included herein. Budget Form 4-B for all funds must be completed and submitted in the manner prescribed by the Department of Local Government Finance.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the **Town of Greenville**.

**ORDINANCE CONCERNING FINES PROVIDED BY THE  
ENFORCEMENT OF STATE OF INDIANA TRAFFIC LAWS WITHIN  
CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA  
AND PAYABLE TO THE FLOYD COUNTY TRAFFIC COURT SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Greenville, Indiana, in the interest of public health, safety and welfare, deemed it necessary that the Town of Greenville passed Ordinance No. 2010-M-087 on 12-13-2010 which defined Speed Limits for Streets, Roadways, Public Ways and Alleyways within the Corporate Limits of the Town of Greenville, Indiana and defined the Greenville Marshal Department as the enforcement authority for the State of Indiana Traffic Codes within the Corporate limits of the Town of Greenville and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Greenville deems it necessary to pass an additional Ordinance which re-defines fees assessed in Ordinance 2011-MO-002 to coincide with the assessments required and payable to the Floyd County Traffic Court System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

If your ticket charges are either an infraction or ordinance violation. If you admit guilt, follow the directions below for payment. If you want to deny and/or be advised of your rights, appear on the court date on your ticket.

Payment cannot be accepted unless the ticket has been filed with the Court, please wait at least 15 business days after receiving your ticket before attempting to pay. If you are eligible to pay there are three methods of payment:

1. Pay in the County Clerk's Office, 311 Hauss Square, Room 235 New Albany, Indiana. Office hours are Monday –Friday, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm. No personal checks accepted. Cash, certified check, cashier's check, money order or Credit/debit is available through PayGov who adds a convenience fee.
2. Pay by credit/debit on the internet. PayGov will add a convenience fee.

3. Pay by credit/debit by a toll free telephone number, 1-866-480-8552. PayGov adds a convenience fee. A Court cause number, example 22D02-, is required for payment online or telephone. You can obtain it by going to [www.floydcounty.in.gov](http://www.floydcounty.in.gov) and click on the link for Floyd County Record Search or by calling 812-948-5414.

6. Tickets issued for Town of Greenville Traffic Ordinance Violations can be appealed to the Town of Greenville, Indiana Prosecuting Attorney Mr. Lane 409 Bank Street, New Albany, Indiana 47150, Telephone {812} 944-5300 to request a dismissal, deferral, or amendment to defective equipment.

Mandatory Court Appearance

The following violations require a Court Appearance. Accidents, driving under the influence, reckless driving, leaving the scene of an accident, driving without ever being licensed, worksite violations 25 MPH and over, driving while suspended, speeding 30 MPH and over, no financial responsibility, expired registration plate or license and, no valid license in possession.

**RESOLUTION PROHIBITING SEMI-TRACTOR TRAILER TRAFFIC ON  
CLARK AND HARRISON STREETS WITHIN THE TOWN OF  
GREENVILLE, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Greenville, Indiana, in the interest of protecting investments in roadways within the Town of Greenville, Indiana and;

WHEREAS, the INDOT {Indiana Department of Transportation} US Highway 150 / Cross Street / Greenville Georgetown Road Signal Light Installation Project could cause unwanted wear and tear on existing asphalt paving on Clark and Harrison Streets and;

WHEREAS, Semi-Tractor Trailer through traffic could use Clark and Harrison Streets as a by-pass around the INDOT construction site;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Definition of Semi-Tractor Trailer Vehicle shall be as described by the State of Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles and Indiana State Code.

2. Definition Local Semi-Tractor Trailer shall mean:

- Any commercial trucking business making pick-up or deliveries at an address on Clark or Harrison Street.
- Any commercial trucking business which their main business location is located on Clark or Harrison Street.

3. Clark Street from Voyles Road running east to Pekin Road shall be designated as Local Semi-Tractor Trailer Traffic Only.

4. Harrison Street from West Third Street running east to East Sixth Street shall be designated as Local Semi-Tractor Trailer Traffic Only.

5. The Town of Greenville shall purchase {8} signs to read LOCAL SEMI-TRACTOR TRAILER TRAFFIC ONLY and {9} sign post no later than one week after passage of this Resolution.

6. Signs shall be double mounted {front/back} and installed at the following location.

- Entry of Clark Street @ Voyles Road.
- On Clark Street on east and west side of Cross Street.
- Entry of Clark Street @ Pekin Road
- Entry of Harrison Street @ West Third Street.
- On Harrison Street on east and west side of Greenville – Georgetown Road.
- Entry of Harrison Street @ East Sixth Street.



7. The Greenville Marshall shall oversee installation and contact Tony Wisman Town of Greenville Maintenance for installation of signs.
8. The Town of Greenville Clerk / Treasurer shall charge the cost of the materials and installation against Town of Greenville Riverboat Inter Fund Transfer Account No. 242001520.
