

Minutes of Greenville Town Council Meeting of November 17, 1992

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Council was called to order by R. L. Lamb, President of the Council with all Councilmembers in attendance and also the Clerk Treasurer/Clerk of the Council.

Also attending was Fred Marsh of SEICO, Gary Gilmore, Mike and Janet Riggs, Gary Getrost, Janice Gibson, and Bill Burkhart, Jr.

The Council approved claims for the town and utility, and the minutes of the last meeting, as read.

The Clerk Treasurers' financial report indicates bank balances appear to be correct.

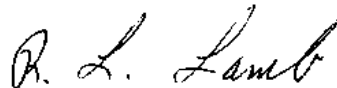
The Council adopted a resolution supporting the allocation of 25% of Lottery revenues to be distributed to local units of government.

Council accepted the resignation of Deputy Marshall William Burkhart, Jr., effective November 30, 1992. As a result of this action Bob Williams directed the Marshalls' car be brought to his home for parking on Mr. Burkharts' last day as Deputy Marshall. This action by Mr. Williams was approved by Council 2-0.

Council was advised by the Clerk of the need to establish voting wards, or abolish wards before the year end. Messrs. Williams and Hall stated they polled their respective wards and it appears the town desires the ward structure for electing their representatives. Messrs. Hall and Williams stated they will survey their respective wards for the population and will also survey the 1st ward.

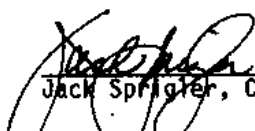
