

## **Minutes of Greenville Town Council Meeting June 13th, 2011**

Council President Talbotte Richardson called the regular monthly meeting to order. Other Councilpersons present were Bob Wright, James Pearce, Patti Hayes, and Randal Johnes, along with Clerk Jack Travillian. Also attending the meeting were Town Attorney Rick Fox, Water Utility Deputy Superintendent Schmidt, and other concerned citizens. The meeting was opened with a prayer by Pastor Avery, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

### **Special Presentations:**

Engineer Jorge Lanz with Jacobi, Toombs, and Lanz presented the council with an update on the SRF funding concerning the 400,000 gallon water storage tower to be erected. The project is currently number 11 (eleven) on the project list for next year.

### **Minutes:**

The amended minutes for May 9th regular meeting, May 9th Public Hearing, and May 23rd Special meeting were discussed. Motion made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Johnes to accept the minutes as amended. Motion passed 5-0.

### **Marshal Report:**

Marshal Moore requested the purchase of audio/video equipment for recording official interrogations. Councilman Johnes noted that the town's financial situation is unclear at this time. Marshal Moore noted that the US military has surplus equipment available that will be shared with local police departments. Marshal Moore reported that he has been accepted to attend training at the Marshal's Academy to become a certified instructor.

### **Water Business:**

Deputy Superintendent Schmidt submitted monthly adjustments to the council. The council approved the adjustments for the bills without objection.

The Water Utility has sold the 2003 Chevrolet S10 pickup truck for \$4,800 on Craig's List. It was sold May 10 on the first day of posting.

### **Financial:**

Review/Approval Checks and Expenditures: Clerk Travillian presented the forms for the checks written from the utility and the town.

### **Special Projects:**

Councilman Johnes updated the council on the installation of a traffic light at the intersection of State Highway 150 and Greenville-Georgetown Road/Cross Street. The light is on schedule to be installed around July of 2012.
