

ORDINANCE NO. 1993.04

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SALARIES AND WAGES FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS AND WATER UTILITY EMPLOYEES FOR THE YEAR 1994


WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Greenville, Floyd County, Indiana, under the statutes and codes of the State of Indiana hereby sets salaries and wages for elected officials and utility employees for the period January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

WHEREAS, the Town Council deems it necessary to provide additional compensation for town elected officials and utility employees for performance of duties interacting with the town and utility.

BE IT ORDAINED, that salaries and wages listed below shall be effective as noted above and paid from various funds as noted:


1. Salary of Town Council President shall be \$2,520.00 per year.
Salary of each (2) Councilmembers shall be \$2,100.00 per year.
Salary of Town Clerk Treasurer shall be \$2,940.00 per year.
2. Salary of Water Superintendent shall be \$13.70 per hour.
Salary of Office Manager shall be \$9.15 per hour.
Salary of Water Utility Operators shall be \$7.15 per hour.
Salary of Temporary Help, Water Utility; Clerical, and Town shall be \$6.00 to \$7.00 per hour, depending on experience.
3. Wages paid for overtime work shall constitute additional compensation.
4. The sum of \$1,920.00 (\$720, \$600, \$600) for Town Councilmembers and \$1,080.00, Clerk Treasurer, shall be paid from Town General Funds.
5. The sum of \$4,800.00 (\$1,800, \$1,500, \$1,500) for Town Councilmembers shall be paid from Utility Funds and \$1,860.00 for Clerk Treasurer shall be paid from Utility Funds.
6. Separate additional compensation, paid from Town General Funds for employees for duties interacting with the town/utility shall be:
 - G. Getrost.....\$ 70.00 per month.
 - J. Gibson 70.00 per month
7. The pay period for town elected officials shall be monthly; utility employees shall be bi-weekly.
8. Should an employee be required to work on a holiday, he/she shall be paid 8 hours at their regular rate in addition to 1/2 rate for actual hours worked. Should a holiday fall on a Saturday or Sunday and the holiday is not observed on a Friday or Monday the employee shall be paid an additional 8 hours pay for the holiday.
9. The hourly rate for active temporary employees may be increased during the current year to the maximum provided by this ordinance upon recommendation of the Clerk Treasurer and/or Water Superintendent and approved by the Council.
