

ORDINANCE NO 95-03

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR TAP-INS  
BY THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE

WHEREAS, the existing charges for new tap-ins installed by the water utility of the Town of Greenville were initially established by Ordinance and are now inadequate to provide for the costs of materials and installation; and,

WHEREAS, it will be necessary to increase the charges in order to pay for the cost of tap-ins; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA:

Section 1. That there shall be and there are hereby established for the use of and the service rendered by the water system of the Town of Greenville, the following charges, for new tap-ins:

5/8 " Tap-in	\$ 450.00
3/4 " Tap-in	450.00
All Others	The actual cost of time, material, equipment and permits.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effective five (5) days after passage unless delayed in accordance with I.C. 8-1.5 -3-8-2.

Passed and adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Greenville, Floyd County, Indiana on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1995.
