

ORDINANCE NO 95-04

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A WATER TAP-IN SURCHARGE

WHEREAS, the Town of Greenville is in an area of Metropolitan Louisville Kentucky which is experiencing rapid growth; and,

WHEREAS, the existing water mains and facilities are inadequate for such growth; and,

WHEREAS, the growth will require larger water mains and facilities to serve the needs of the growth area and to maintain existing levels of service; and,

WHEREAS, it is unfair and unreasonable to require existing customers to bear the burden of the costs of future growth; and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable to charge each new service/tap-in a surcharge to more adequately prepare for future improvements necessitated by such growth;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED that such new service/tap-in shall be assessed a surcharge as follows:

5/8"	\$ 500.00
3/4"	500.00
1"	1,000.00
1 1/2"	1,500.00
2"	2,000.00
3"	3,000.00
4"	4,000.00
5"	5,000.00
6"	6,000.00


Said surcharge is to be paid with the tap-in fees in existence at the time of application for water service.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effective five (5) days after passage unless delayed in accordance with I.C. 8-1.5-3-8-2.

Passed and adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Greenville, Floyd County, Indiana on the 9th day of May 1995.



Indiana Code requires this notice be mailed to all users **outside** of the town. Users in town receive notice by attending town board meetings and advertising in the local paper. Please note: this will NOT affect users currently on the system, unless they need a new service meter.
