

RESOLUTION CONCERNING INCREASE IN TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP

The Greenville Town Council hereby adopts the following as a resolution, in accordance with the provisions of Indiana Code 36-5-2-4.2:

1. It is the decision of the Council to submit to the voters of the Town a public question concerning an increase in the number of members on the Town Council.

2. The Council is proposing that the size of the council be increased from three member to five members.

3. The date of the election at which this public question will appear on the ballot is November 7, 1995

4. The following question will be placed on the ballot in the form provided by Indiana Code 3-10-9-4:

"Shall the number of Town Council members be increased from three to five?"
